



Group Basic Life and Accidental Death and Dismemberment Insurance

Group Basic Life insurance from Standard Insurance Company helps provide financial protection by promising to pay a benefit in the event of an eligible member's, or his or her dependent's covered death. Basic Accidental Death and Dismemberment (AD&D) insurance may provide an additional amount in the event of a covered death or dismemberment as a result of an accident.

The cost of this insurance is paid by Cherokee County School District, except for the cost of your dependent's insurance, which is paid by you through payroll deduction. Enrollment materials needed to elect coverage will be provided.

Eligibility

Definition of a Member	<p>You are a member if you are a regular full-time employee of Cherokee County School District (other than an attendant, bus driver or monitor) and actively working at least 30 hours each week OR a regular full-time attendant, bus driver or monitor of Cherokee County School District and actively working at least 20 hours each week.</p> <p>You are not a member if you are a temporary or seasonal employee, a full-time member of the armed forces, a leased employee or an independent contractor.</p>
Eligibility Waiting Period	<p>You are eligible on the first of the month that follows 30 consecutive days as a member.</p>

Benefits

Basic Life Coverage Amount	<p>1 times your annual earnings to a maximum of \$50,000, with a minimum coverage amount of \$15,000.</p>
Basic AD&D Coverage Amount	<p>For a covered accidental loss of life, your Basic AD&D coverage amount is equal to your Basic Life coverage amount. For other covered losses, a percentage of this benefit will be payable.</p>
Life Age Reductions	<p>Basic Life and AD&D insurance coverage amount reduces to 65 percent at age 70 and to 50 percent at age 75.</p>

Basic Dependent Life Coverage Amount

The Basic Dependent Life coverage amount for your eligible spouse is \$10,000. Your spouse is the person to whom you are legally married, or your domestic partner as recognized by law or by your employer's domestic partnership policy, if applicable.

The Basic Dependent Life coverage amount for each of your eligible children is \$10,000. Child means your child from live birth through age 25.
