### Types of FSA Accounts:



#### Health Care FSA

The Health Care FSA is used to pay for eligible out-of-pocket medical expenses not paid by insurance or other sources.

- Copays, Deductibles
- Prescriptions
- Glasses, Contacts
- Braces, and more

#### **Use It or Roll It Over!**

Roll over up to **\$680** of unused Health Care FSA dollars, giving you more flexibility and less year-end pressure.



#### Dependent Care FSA (DCAP)

The Dependent Care FSA is used to pay for eligible child or elder care expenses.

- Daycare
- Elder Care
- Before/After School Care
- Summer Day Camp (kids under 13)

#### **Important DCAP Reminder:**

You have **60 days after the plan year ends** to submit DCAP claims. Unused funds will be forfeited.

Roll Over: up to \$680

Up to \$7,500  
(\$3,750 if filing separately)
